Born in Cuneo in 1970, after high school he enrolls in humane letters (classics) at the University of Turin and graduates “cum laude” in 1994. For a long time active in associationism and voluntary work, in 1995 he’s co-founder of the “Emmaus” community in Boves, devoting after then to the ACLIs (Christian Associations of the Italian workers), of which he becomes national President in 2006. In December 2012 he abandons every associative role and begins his political activity, as a founding member of the “Scelta Civica” movement. In February 2013 he is elected senator and becomes a member of the sixth permanent Committee of Finance and Treasury; in December 2014 he joins the parliamentary group “Gruppo per le autonomie”. In February 2014 he has been appointed Vice Minister of Agricultural Food and Forestry Policies. He is delegated to follow these thematic issues: Central Inspectorate of quality protection and repression of frauds in connection with agricultural products; Problems related to the tobacco sector at national and EU level; Activities connected to the Rural Network; Organic Farming, Social Agriculture and Biodiversity; Beekeeping; Relations with Universities and Schools regarding education in agriculture; “Agromafie”.
